Players now start their planning for the 14's and 15' Country Championships in Waga in three weeks time, with rep trials this weekend against Group 10 in Oberon.



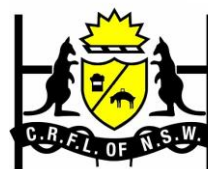

Thirlmere have advanced to the Group 6 Rugby League Grand Final following a comprehensive win over Camden, while Picton have outclassed The Oaks, who couldn't repeat last week's heroics in the Minor Semi Final.

The Roosters booked their ticket to the Norman L Day Cup decider at Campbelltown Stadium in two weeks' time, after blowing Camden out of the park, with a 48-22 win at Harvey Shephard Field.

Thirlmere again jumped out of the blocks quickly, when big front rower Dane Coskerie crashed over after only two minutes, giving the Roosters a perfect start against the Rams at home. Jackson Willis then restored parity for the home team, who were ironically the visitors in the game, before Ben Weir stormed over from close range, giving the Rams a 10-6 lead after 15 minutes.

But that was where the highlights ended for the locals, as Thirlmere ran riot after that. Tries to Kye Madden, Jacob Loko, and Josh Bryant before halftime, saw the Roosters take a 24-10 lead into the rooms at halftime.

Halftime only provided brief respite for the Rams' supporters and players alike, as Thirlmere continued on their merry way in the second half. Dayne Craig scored the first of his two tries just after play resumed, before Camden's Corey White returned serve, giving the Rams a glimmer of hope 10 minutes in the second period.

That glimmer was shut down quickly, when the Roosters scored tries through Allan Shipley, Josh Bryant and Craig's second on the final siren. The only highlight for the Rams was a try to Jack Davey with 14 minutes left on the clock.

The final score of 48-22 showed the difference in class between the two sides, as Thirlmere dominated the match throughout, with Camden left to ponder what might have been. They were forced to watch the Minor Semi Final, knowing they would face the winner next Sunday in Picton.

The Minor Semi Final between Picton and The Oaks was not as exciting, but the Magpies showed their class in recording a 38-12 win over the Tigers, who bowed out of the finals race at the second hurdle.

Picton opened the scoring through an Anthony Provost penalty goal, before the No. 9 scored a nice solo try on 11 minutes to make the margin 8 points. Backrower Bryce Ritchie-Manns, who started off the bench, added his name to the list ten minutes later, as the Magpies took control of the first half. Joey Peato (who finished with two tries) scored before halftime, as the Magpies took control of the match, leading 20-6 at halftime. The only highlight for the Tigers was a brilliant solo try to Alex Canham, who tiptoed down the western touchline, beating several defenders to score in the corner.

The second half was a more-dour affair, with points not coming so freely after the halftime break. The opening try came 20 minutes into the second term, when Peato added his second of the day. With the score at 26-6, the game was all but sealed for the Magpies, who did well to shut the game down. Tries in the final ten minutes to Taulima Tautai and Bryce Hoskins sealed the win, with Mitchell Brasington getting a consolation try six minutes before time for the Tigers.

Camden will now meet Picton in the Preliminary Final at Victoria Park next Sunday, for the right to play in the Grand Final. The Rams will need to regroup to face the Magpies again, after meeting last week in the Qualifying Final, with Camden proving too strong last time out in a tough affair.
